Make new artist friends while creating new art! Here's your chance to meet and paint alongside **artists from all over Hays County**, all in the great outdoors of course!

As part of an initiative of the **Hays County Arts Alliance (HCAA)**, **WVAL** joins **Buda, Dripping Springs, and San Marcos** in hosting four **plein air* painting events** in March and April, giving artists the opportunity to paint in **multiple communities**.

Each community event will take place on a different date and at a different location, culminating in **one celebratory exhibition** featuring selected paintings from **all four communities**.

Artists of all experience levels are encouraged to participate!

Plein Air Wimberley will take place at **Blue Hole Regional Park** on **Saturday, March 28, from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.** The theme is **"Water,"** with activities beginning at the Swim Lawn along Cypress Creek.

The other events are scheduled for **March 7 – Buda, April 11 – Dripping Springs, and April 25 – San Marcos**. Details will follow.

Our day at Wimberley's Blue Hole will include **plein air demonstrations** and a **Q&A session** led by local artists. **Lunch will be provided**, and participants are invited to enjoy

the demonstrations and **gather tips and inspiration.**

Cost of the Blue Hole event is **\$20 for WVAL members**** and **\$30 for non-members.** A similar price will apply to the other communities.

* **Plein air painting**, or *en plein air* (French for "in the open air"), is the act of **painting outdoors on-site** to capture the immediate, fleeting effects of light, atmosphere, and color in real-time.

A little bit about Gena:

Gena Destri is an **award-winning contemporary landscape painter** whose art draws from nature's energy and the emotions it helps us carry, sweep away, or transform. **Born in Kansas and living in the Austin area** for nearly 20 years, she is drawn to the **ancestral qualities of land, water, and sky.**

*Working en plein air and from memory in her Texas studio, Destri creates impressionistic paintings in **oil, watercolor, and acrylic** that explore how **grass, clouds, and shifting light** shape what the soul needs. Her work offers both the **vitality and calm of nature**, connecting viewers to its beauty, wisdom, and ever-changing presence. Through her practice, **she hopes to remind us of what is good in the world** and to inspire a **deeper relationship with its wonder.***

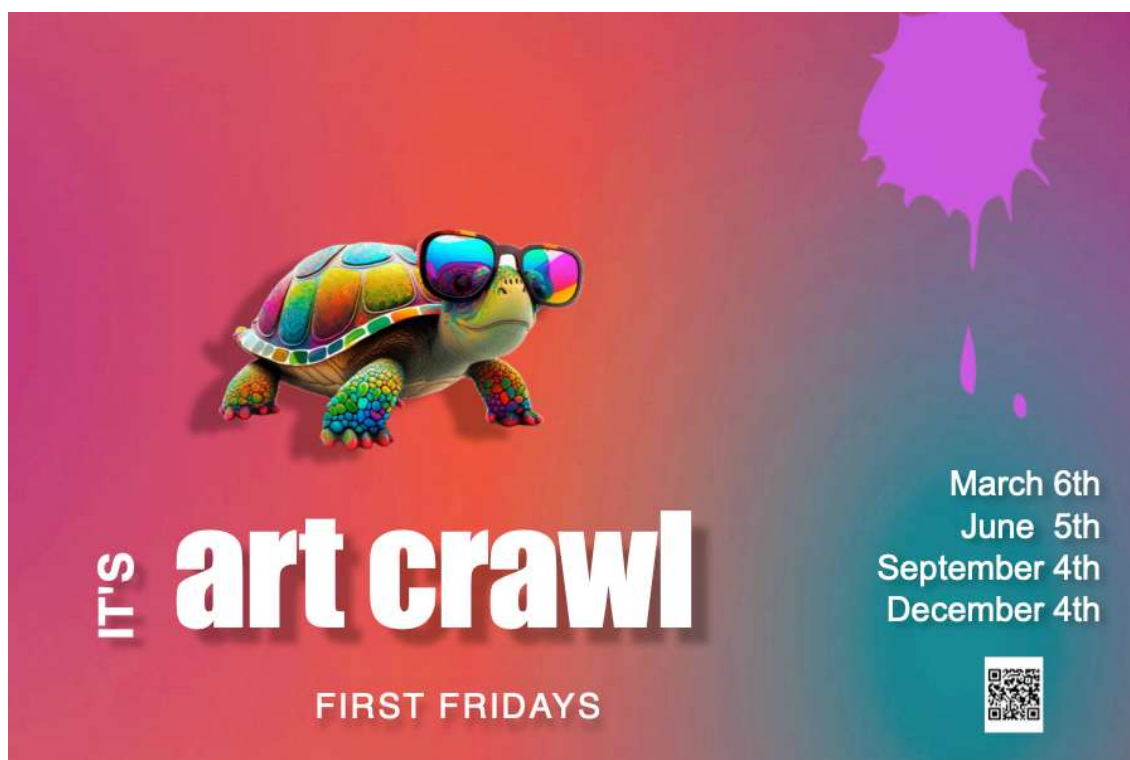
